Post Fire Rebuild Information

- Building plans must be stamped by the District(s) to confirm Single Family Equivalency (SFE) rating is same as previously assessed.
 - Adding a kitchen or another building connected to the sewer/water are among the circumstances in which another SFE tap must be purchased. If you have questions about your SFE rating contact the office.
- We highly recommend a plumber inspect your service line(s) prior to connection to ensure no damage was done to your line(s). There are several local plumbers who can also scope the line if needed.
- If damage to the line is discovered and reconnection to the District's infrastructure is required you will need to get a Connection/Inspection Permit from the District(s). Permit cost is \$25 for Three Lakes Water & Sanitation District and \$50 for Columbine Lake Water District. Contact the office should this occur.
- If damage to your backflow/preventor sewer valve is discovered you can purchase a new valve from Three Lakes Water & Sanitation District. The District charges product cost only, which is currently \$153.42. Contact the office should this occur.
